Many thanks for your contribution of \$500 to the Bishop's Fund to assist people who suffered damage from the recent tornadoes in Arkansas. It means so much to see the significant support coming from so many sources.

Our approach to relief work has focused on recommendations from members of the clergy in the areas that were affected. They made recommendations on how much money each person might need and how the money should be distributed. Some people are Episcopalians; others are simply people in the community who have lost much. In some cases, we were able to send checks directly to the affected people; in other cases, the gift was handled by the member of the clergy because some people no longer have a current mailing address, while others do not have a checking account. In all cases, we decided that the people needed cash to purchase the items or services they knew that they needed. rather than this office guessing which supplies people might need.

If you marked your donation for a specific area, such as Wynne, we honored that request. All the donations go 100% toward relief work. There is no administrative charge.

Again, I thank you for your generosity. Our help to others in times such as these is one of the times that the church is at its best. With every best wish, I remain
